Conservancy Man Earned \$500 A Month!

In Selangor, an Indian conservancy worker for Broome Estate, Bukit Tunggus Estate, and for Bangi village, was found to be earning \$300 per month. Until recently he earned \$500 per month, but he found the work too strenuous and has curtailed his itinerary. Miscellaneous places of employment visited in the Klang area showed an increase of approximately 20 to 25 per cent over wages as reported at the last inspection. Most of these increases were granted in the first six months of 1951, says the December Report of the Labour Department.
