### Hindu Ceremonies.

The wedding took place on Friday, Feb. 2, at Kampong Atap, Kuala Lumpur, of Mr. R. Sathasivam, of the railway goods office, to Miss Manonmany Ammal, eldest daughter of Mr. S. K.
