## A Crepe Folder.

### Selangor Planter's Invention,

The Colony of the Straits Settlements had granted to Mr. Frederick Rothwell Holt, of Broome Estate, Bangi, Selangor, a grant of exclusive privileges, Patent No. 317, for a "crepe rubber folder." The Chief Secretary, F.M.S., has also accepted a complete specification filed by Mr. Holt for the crepe folder.

The object of this invention is to fold crepe rubber after drying by machinery or by hand, and to save time and labour. To drive the folder requires very little mechanical power and it can also be driven by hand. The Federated Engineering Co., Ltd., are now making this machine, and it will shortly be on the market. The inventor claims that these machine will be the means of saving many hundred dollars, and that three machines alone, running at about twenty revolutions per minute, will do the work of nine coolies and save over a thousand dollars per year.—M.M.
