The Sandbills Murder.

The execution of Frederick Rothwell Holt, convicted and sentenced to be hanged at Manchester Assizes for murdering Miss Breaks on the Sandhills, St Anne's, on Dec 23, was to have taken place at Strangeways gael on March 16. We are told says the "Pinang Gazette" that, Holt's brief planting career in the F M S was on Broome Estate, Bangi, Selangor, in 1917. He was there for four or five months-long enough, however to invent a patent crepe packer, which has been found very useful in rabber export, since it packs crepe into a very small space. After inventing the Holt Crepe Folder he left for England via Japan and America, having sold his invention to the F E Coy for a lump sum The heat out here sflected him a great deal, owing to shellshock during the war. He was a well built and powerful man. Holt was always very anxious to get home again.
