TAMBIRA RUBBER.

Change Of Feeling In Holland.

The annual general meeting of the Tambira Rubber Estates, L.d., was held on May 3 at the offices of the company, 71 St. Mary-ax, E.C.

Mr. E. B. Skinner, the chairman, who presided, said that they had sustained a trading loss for the year of £4,050, comparing with £6,408 in 1931. The estate expenditure had been reduced by over £3,200, and the receipts by £856.

For the current year a further reduction in working costs was anticipated. Financial resources were getting low, but the matter was receiving careful consideration and in the meantime the estates were being run at the cheapest possible rate.

It was hoped that Tamboenan and S. Biroeng expenditure would be balanced by the receipts from rubber. They had sold forward 5 tons per month at 9 cents per ½ kg. and 5 tons per month at 11¼ cents per ½ kg. for the whole of 1933. Those sales covered about 30 per cent. of the total estimated crop.

The final position at 31st December last was a debit balance of £10,606, but nearly £3,000 represented Debenture interest.

With regard to the position of the industry, as far as one could judge there had been a definite change of feeling in Holland about the desirability of some form of control, but the difficulty was to produce a scheme which would satisfy the Government in the D.E. Indies that the native producer could be adequately and fairly controlled, and it might be some time before they could expect the D.E.I. Government to take definite action.

The report and accounts were unanimously adopted.
