SHOT BOY DIES

KUALA LUMPUR, Friday.— Robert Downey, 10-year-old boy who was shot in the head by bandit fire when a convoy of evacuating European families was ambushed on Wednesday afternoon about a mile south of the village of Kachau, Selangor, died in hospital today.

His father, Mr. J. Downey, manager of the Dominion Estate, Kachau, who received a gunshot wound in his arm, is reported to be in a worse condition now than when he was admitted to hospital. The bullet that struck him is said to have been deflected into the shoulder from the arm.

The Malay driver who was shot through the chest was stated to be "progressing."
