

KUALA LUMPUR, Mon. — The acting director of the Mara Institute of Technology, Inche Hijjas bin Kasturi, and a special students' committee have begun a full inquiry into the circums-

tances leading to the nervous breakdown of a girl student, Che Shukra binte Datuk Kampo Radjo.

"If it is found that her nervous breakdown was the result of ragging, the senior student or students responsible will be liable to instant dismissal," Inche Hijjas said.

Che Shukra, 17, was admitted to the Assunta Hose pital on April 8 after only two days at the coliege.


Phone calls


