More parks for Bangi

Massive riverbank project to maintain town's green image

HE Selangor Development Corporation will carry out more beautification and landscape projects in Bandar Baru Bangi to maintain its image of a "University and Garden

City" and to cater to its

increasing population. The corporation's (PKNS) Bandar Baru Bangi development controller Raihani Sulaiman said besides the completed Taman Cempaka lake garden at Section 9, another massive landscape project would be carried out along the one-kilometre stretch of the Sungal Ramal riverbank that cuts through Section 7 of the township.

The new garden will offer more recreational facilities. Raihani said the landscape and park project would be caried out in three phases.

The first started early this month and will be completed by the end of next

year.

She said both sides of the riverbanks — from the roundabout that joins Section 7 and Section 4 to the river mouth at Sungai Langat — would be developed into a riverside garden, with trees and flowering plants, logging tracks, children's

playground and rest areas.

The second phase will be carried out with the National Landscape Department and Kajang Municipal Council

It will include a public library, hawker centre and beautification work on the Sungai Air Hitam riverbank nearest the PKNS Complex.

"PKNS will also beautify two former mining ponds opposite Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) and turn them into a picnic and fishing area for residents in Section 1 and Section 2 as well as UKM students," said Raihani.

"PKNS will also plant more trees along road dividers, road shoulders, the Sungai Langat riverbank, public parks and empty spaces in the township."

She said the new recreational facilities would meet the demand for such places, when more people moved into the Section 7 residential zone which is expected to be occupied by the end of next year.

"There are some 2,000 residential units in that section. They comprise 700 low-cost flats, 550 medium-cost flats and 800 double-storey terraced houses."
