## SELANGOR NEWS.

Kuala Lumpur, 23rd October.

EUROPEAN Warder Pharaoh from Batu Gajah has arrived in Seremban, to act as Gaoler there.

THE Victoria Institution will equip a first class laboratory in the new extension, which will shortly be completed.

It is said that the Sanitary Board will from next year extend its jurisdiction to Weld's Hill, where bungalows are springing up like mushrooms.

Mr. N. Grenier has taken over the Secretaryship of the Selangor Fire Brigade from Mr. R. Charter, who has been transferred to Ulu Langkat.

Mr. Alexander, the Assistant Treasurer, having resumed duty, Mr. Fonseca, the Cadet, who has been acting for him, has been transferred to Perak.
