Accommodation.

With regard to accommodation Mr. Campbell informs us that in order to provide for visitors who have not obtained other accommodation the Committee have provided beds with mosquito curtains in rooms at the Victoria Institution kindly lent for the occasion by the Trustees. One wing will be reserved for ladies in which there will be three or four rooms containing, if needed, 4, 6 and 10 beds respectively. A contract has been arranged for suitable meals with good menu. Charge \$7/- per diem payable in advance, to include Bed and Breakfast, Tiffin and Dinner. The Committee cannot guarantee accommodation unless it is booked before August 2-3.
