F.M.S. Railways Concessions.

Kuala Lumpur, Oct. 10.

The F.M.S. Railways are introducing cheap single and return tickets between Seremban and Sepang Road, Labu, Rembau, Tampin and Malacca stations, as from Saturday.

A second class return ticket from Malacca to Seremban and vice versa will cost \$1.80.

The return tickets will be available for the return journey on the day of issue or on the following day.

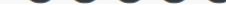
