Kuala Lumpur, Oct. 29.

Owing to heavy rain mail trains were delayed last night, the sections most affected being between Serendah and Sungei Choh and between Kajang and Bangi.

The line is now repaired, and trains are able to pass at a reduced speed.

The Singapore mail arrived at Kuala Lumpur 28 minutes late today, the Penang mail 35 minutes late, and the mails to Singapore and Penang were some hours late.
