## \$303,000 FOR ROADS AND BUILDINGS. SELANGOR PLANS.

(From Our Own Correspondent)  
Kuala Lumpur, Nov. 14.

A PROVISION of \$303,000 for the maintenance of buildings and roads, with a view to catching up with the arrears of work caused by the slump, was included in the expenditure estimates when the Supply Bill, 1936, came before today's meeting of the Selangor State Council for its final reading.

In moving the Bill, the State Treasurer, Mr. A. Sleep, said that the total provision of \$10,755,899 was \$1,625,899 more than for the year before, and the estimated excess of expenditure over revenue was \$1,881,009.

"There is an extra provision for Malay Vernacular Education, both for trained teachers and for new school buildings at Kampong Bahru, Kuala Lumpur, at Sungei Tuah, Ulu Klang, and Bangi; also for a hostel at the High School, Klang, and for extensions to existing schools," said Mr. Sleep. "There are also building grants to the Methodist Boys' Schools, Sentul, \$24,250, and to the Pudu English School, \$12,000.

"Additional money is provided under Medical and Health Services for hospital diets and for drugs.

### \$100,000 Astana Repairs.

"There is an increase of \$100,000 under maintenance of buildings, and \$203,000 under maintenance of roads, with the object of wiping-off arrears of maintenance work due to the slump. \$26,000 is to be spent on an Admission and Casualty Ward, General Hospital, Kuala Lumpur, \$20,000 as the first vote on an Anti-malarial Drainage Scheme, Sungei Buloh, Klang, and Sydney Lake, Kuala Lumpur, is to be re-conditioned at a cost of \$45,000.

"Repairs and alterations to the Astana, Klang, are to be carried out at a cost of \$100,000. New quarters are to be provided for Government Officers in Kuala Lumpur, and existing quarters improved, by items amounting to \$122,500.

"There is increased provision of \$277,910 for the maintenance of the electrical supply, Kuala Lumpur, to
