SUNGEI RAMAL PROFIT FALLS HEAVILY

From \$68,726 In 1937 To \$8,464 Last Year



A NET profit of \$8,464 was earned by Sungei Ramal Syndicate Ltd. in the year ended December last. This compares with \$68,726 in the preceding year. To this has been added \$19,623 brought forward from 1937, making a total of \$28,087.

The directors recommend a dividend of 2 per cent., which, if approved, will require \$8,000 and they propose that the balance of \$20,087 be carried forward, subject to payment of directors' fees. For 1937 a dividend of 12 per fees. cent. was paid.

The crop harvested in 1938 was 267,578 lb. compared with 411,250 lb. in 1937. The average net price realised for first-grade rubber sold was 22.83 cents a lb. For 1939 the standard production has been assessed at 549,800 lb. compared with 427,045 lb. in 1938. Income from tribute on mining operations totalled \$544.

The Board consists of Messrs. E. G. Leyne, D. H. Hampshire and A. Beckett. Mr. Leyne retires but seeks re-election and Neill and Bell offer themselves for reappointment as auditors. The annual meeting is to be held in Kuala Lumpur on Apr. 3.

The accounts show that \$2,716 was received in interest; \$21 in transfer fees; \$55 in sundry receipts and \$544 from tribute on mining. Manager's commission for the year charged in the accounts is \$510.
