Electricity for 24 villages by year end



KUALA LUMPUR, Mon. - Twenty-four villages and kampongs in Selangor with a population of more than 9,000 will be supplied with electricity by the end of the year.


Most of the villages are in the Ulu Langat district where 10 schemes have already been completed with eight sub-stations. Connections to homes will be made soon,

The villages in Ulu Langat district which have already been connected with electricity are Dusun Tua, Sungei Lui, Kampong Perdek, Kampong Lucok Kelubi, Dengkil, Sungei Ramai, Kampong Sg. Gabal and Kampong Lawa Gahal and Kampong Jawa.

These kampongs are being lighted up under part of a programme started in 1961 to bring electricity to more than 30,000.

So far the C.E.B. has spent \$951.700 of which the Government contributed \$625,100 for rural electrification projects.
