This 1930 building in Kajang Town was owned by Low Boon Liew. In 1907, Low owned 3 shophouses in Town, was active in rubber planting & operated a brick kiln. He was the only one Chinese appointed to the five-member District Licensing Board for 1926-1927. The facade carries 2 plaster-carved flags which signify Guomindang & the Republic of China. The old buildings & walls in old Towns are embedded with stories & history.
