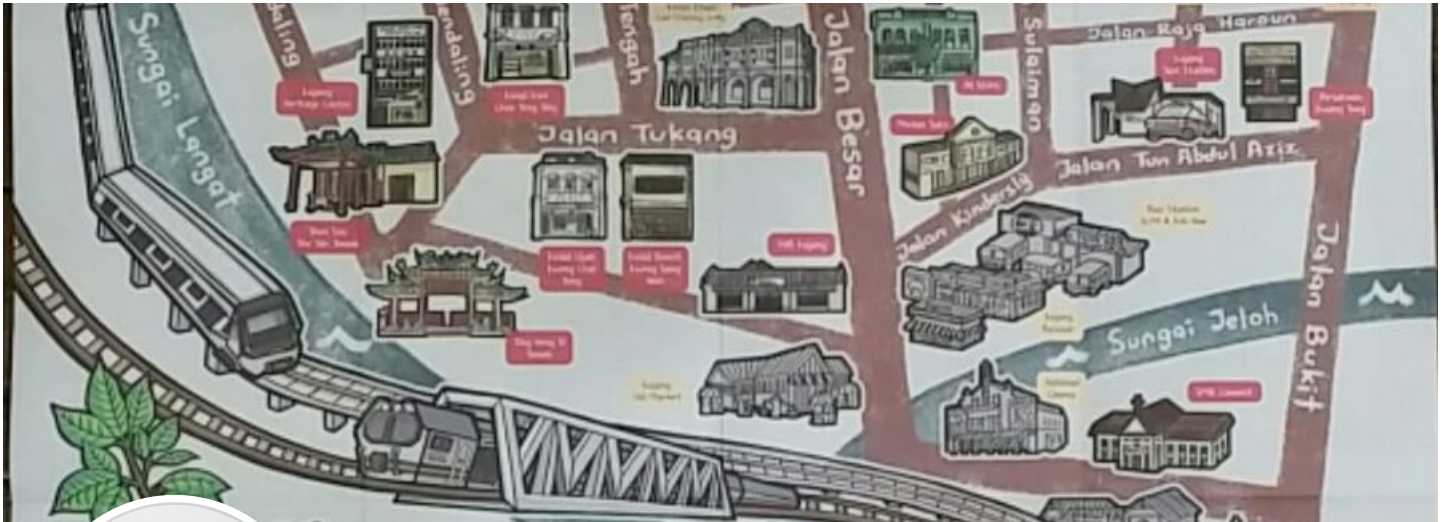

Kajang, a Tin Mining Town.

Kajang started as a market place in 1860s where goods and produce were exchanged. Exploration for tin had been the main attraction in pulling migrants from Sumatra and Hakka labourers into Hulu Langat. Earliest recorded site of tin mining was at Rekoh, about 4 km from present Kajang. This is how Jln Reko, the road leading to UKM got its name. Frank Swettenham visited Rekoh in 1875 described the town had been a glorious place. Another tin mining area was at Bukit Arang, near Hulu Langat 14th Mile. Towkay Chin Ah Chan was invited by Sultan Abdul Samad in 1868 to open up mines along upstream of the Langat River. This brought about the establishment of Hulu Langat 14th Mile town. Kajang was mentioned of a tin mine not far from Langat River in town. Or latest document from National Archive show the location in a 1896 map. The present Metro Plaza site was a mining pool. It was owned by Towkay Chow Yoke. Chow Yoke built and

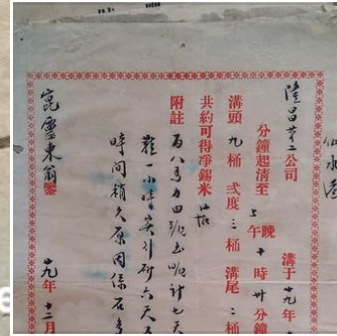
