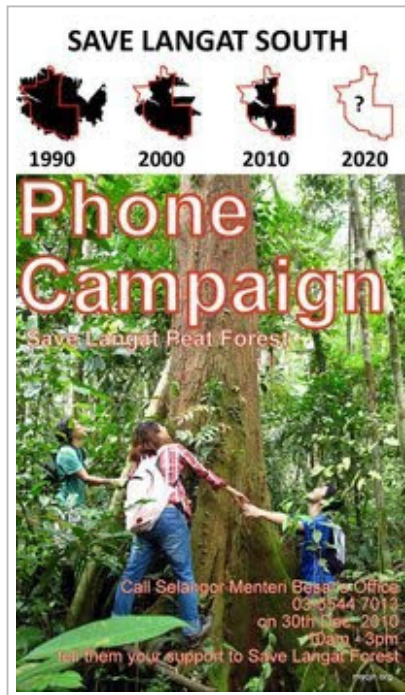

Save Langat South Forest Campaign

Description: Langat South is a peat-swamp forest next to KLIA airport in Malaysia.

The forest is under threat from vegetable farmers and oil palm plantations companies.

In 1927, an area of 12,141 hectares were declared to be a forest reserve but illegal logging and burning has cut the forest back to around 5000 ha today.

THE Selangor branch of the Malaysian Nature Society (MNS) would like to congratulate the Selangor Forestry Department for taking action against the illegal encroachment on the Kuala Langat South Forest Reserve. MNS notes that the reserve was originally 12,141ha, but has since been denuded to fewer than 5,000ha of forest today. We hope that the Forestry Department will replant the degraded areas. We also hope that a system of monitoring can be put in place to prevent encroachment. MNS notes that scientists from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia conducting research in Langat South have found that the forest is rich in biodiversity, with a potential for finding species new to science. We hope that the Selangor government will continue to protect this important forest and, thus, safeguard its rich biological resource
