Sejarah Ringkas

[Sejarah Ladang Prang Besar](#): Ladang Prang Besar dibuka pada 16 Ogos 1921: *“On 16 August 1921, 900 acres of jungle land was granted to nine officers returned from the Great War as the First World War (1914-1918) was known at the time. During the next three years, this acreage was increased to 2026 acres as other officers who had served in the war took up grants of adjacent land given by the Government. It was the policy of the Government of the day to alienate land to serving British officers to encourage rubber cultivation. The original nine officers formed a private company to develop the block of virgin jungle selected by Gough. They named the company Prang Besar Estate Ltd. in commemoration of the Great War, “the war to end all wars”, in which they had fought. The seal or chop adopted by Prang Besar Estate showed a young rubber tree rising out of a shell explosion and was designed by one of the nine, Lt. Commander JC Amcotts, DSC, RN. Another pioneer was Commander GHA Willis, CB, RN, who had a field Ladang Willis named after him. ETH Gough remained a Director of Prang Besar Estate Ltd until his death in 1952.”* (VD Nair (Pengurus estet Prang Besar tahun 1950-an), 1990-an:

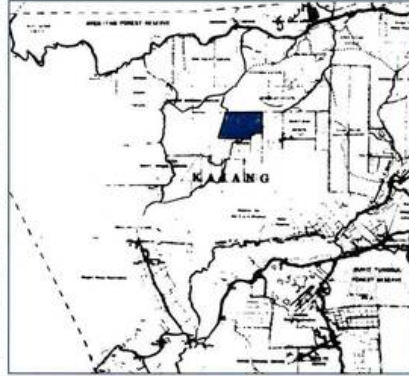
Pusat Benih Getah Antarabangsa

SEJARAH awal Prang Besar bermula dengan tertubuhnya Prang Besar Estate Limited pada 16 April 1921 di Mokim Kajang lalu di sekitar kawasan Hutannya Ayer Hitam dan Jalan Telok Datoh yang meliputi kawasan seluas lebih kurang 900 ekar. Ladang ini dinamakan Prang Besar yang bermakna Great War, kemudian diterjemahkan sebagai Prang Besar mengambil sempena Perang Dunia Pertama. Kesemua pemilik tanah ini terdiri daripada bekas-bekas tentera British yang pernah menyertai perang tersebut. Mereka adalah Mejar E.H.T. Gough, Kapten K.C. Turley, Kapten H.S. Hewett, Kapten P.K. Paul, Major C. Burn Callander, Mejar C. Burn Murdoch, Lett. F. St. Barbe, Lieut. J. Crockett-Amcotts dan Lett. kol. S.W. Bunker.

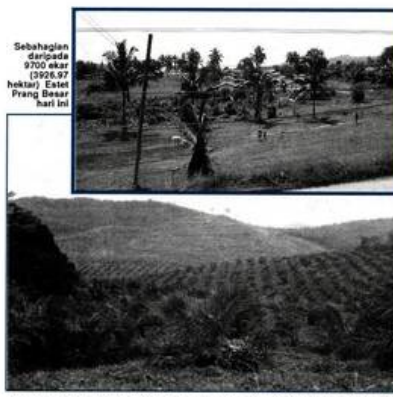
Pemberian tanah ini adalah melalui satu skim yang diperkenalkan oleh kerajaan British dan dinamakan "War Service Land Grant Scheme". Skim ini telah diwartakan dalam F.M.S. Supplement Gazette No. 771 pada 14 Februari 1920. Warta ini dikeluarkan bagi menerangkan bagaimana cara permohonan boleh dibuat dan setiap permohonan hendaklah dimajukan kepada "Central Registry, War Service Land Scheme, Kuala Lumpur" dalam dua salinan.

Di bawah skim ini, setiap bekas tentera British yang hendak mengemukakan permohonan mereka mestilah seorang rakyat British atau rakyat di empat buah negeri dalam Negeri-Negeri Melayu Bersatu; pernah menyertai peperangan sebagai seorang tentera British; mempunyai pekerjaan yang tetap di Negeri-Negeri Melayu Bersatu semasa peperangan meletus dan juga semasa permohonan dikemukakan. Sekiranya permohonan tersebut berjaya, mereka akan diberi 100 ekar tanah seorang. Pemberian tanah hanya akan dihadkan di tiga buah negeri di utara Tanah Melayu dan tanah-tanah tersebut perlu diserahkan untuk

pertanian sahaja. Selepas tiga tahun penubuhannya, kawasan Ladang Prang Besar ini bertambah kepada 2026 ekar dengan mengambil alih tanah-tanah bekas tentera British yang lain melalui beberapa perjanjian. Pada permulaannya Ladang ini lebih merumpukan perhatiannya kepada kerja-kerja mencantumkan tunas-tunas getah untuk mendapatkan benih yang lebih baik di samping meletakkan asas yang kukuh dalam menggiatkan benih-benih dan pokok-pokok getah yang bermutu tinggi. Orang yang memainkan peranan penting dalam pelaksanaan



Kejayaan Ladang Prang Besar dalam hal ini tidak dapat disangkal; membolehkan ladang ini diletakkan setaraf dengan Institut Penyelidikan Getah (IRI) dalam pelbagai penyelidikan benih getah. Kejayaan ladang ini merupakan hasil usaha Dr. Chittenden dan Kapten R.O. Jenkins yang sentiasa mencari pem-

Sumatra dan Afrika Barat disemai daripada benih-benih yang diturunkan di ladang ini. Perkembangan pesat Ladang Prang Besar ini merupakan hasil kemudahan-kemudahan dan dorongan dua adibekas K. Kinderley dan K. Farley. Pengurus Ladang Sedgely semenjak tahun 1913. Di Ladang Prang Besar ini juga terdapat sebuah kilang pemproses (SMI) daripada hasil getah yang ditanam di ladang ini. Selain itu ladang ini dijadikan pusat penyelidikan untuk menghasilkan pelbagai peremaman benih getah. Pusat penyelidikan ini diawasi oleh Mejar E.H.T. Gough sendiri bertujuan menghasilkan klon-klon getah yang bermutu tinggi untuk dipasarkan ke seluruh dunia. Kini Ladang Prang Besar akan mengalami satu lagi perkembangan yang besar, melalui pengisytiharan Warta Kerajaan Negeri Selangor No. 1019 pada tahun 1993 bahawa kawasan seluas 1671 hektar milik Ladang Prang Besar dan 381 hektar milik Ladang Galloway akan diambil alih untuk Pusat Pentadbiran Kerajaan Persekutuan Prang Besar.

1924-04-30: Lawatan Secretary of Agriculture Berkenaan Eksperimen Cantuman Tunas

"Office of Secretary for Agriculture, Federated Malay States, & Straits Settlements. Kuala Lumpur, 16th May, 1924.

Sir, I have the honour to forward for submission to the Hon'ble the British Resident a note on a visit paid by me recently to the Prang Besar Estate, Kajang. 2. Some publicity has recently been given in the local Press to this experiment in bud-grafting rubber. 3. A report on Brown Bast experiments in the course of which possible dangers of Bud-grafting are pointed out. In addition to publication numerous demonstrations were given at Headquarters and in Outstations on the technique of Bud-grafting and in July 1922 the Plant Physiologist delivered a very instructive lecture at Malacca in which he advocated that work be undertaken in Malaya. Since July 1922 the position has remained unchanged. Various results

published in the Netherlands East Indies shew no finality and give no ground for extreme optimism. 4. In 1922 the question of seed-selection was discussed by the Advisory Committee and, in view of the financial situation, experiments thereanent were shelved. Afterwards the formation of a "Co-operative Society for Bud-grafting and Seed Selection" was discussed. This has been side-tracked in view of the creation of a Rubber Research Institute. 5. At present a few Estates (notably Prang Besar) are laying down bud-grafts but apparently, not in such a way as will admit of precision in deduction from results. At Prang Besar Estate for example (an excellently run Estate) the factors of seed selection, soil conservation and close planting (with a view to thinning out the bad ones) have to be borne in mind. If, as we all hope, success above other Estates is achieved this will not necessarily be a result of bud-grafting. 6. It is now proposed by articles in the Malayan Agricultural Journal to stress the desirability of measures by each considerable Estate for the provision of its own bud-wood - merely as an insurance if nothing else. 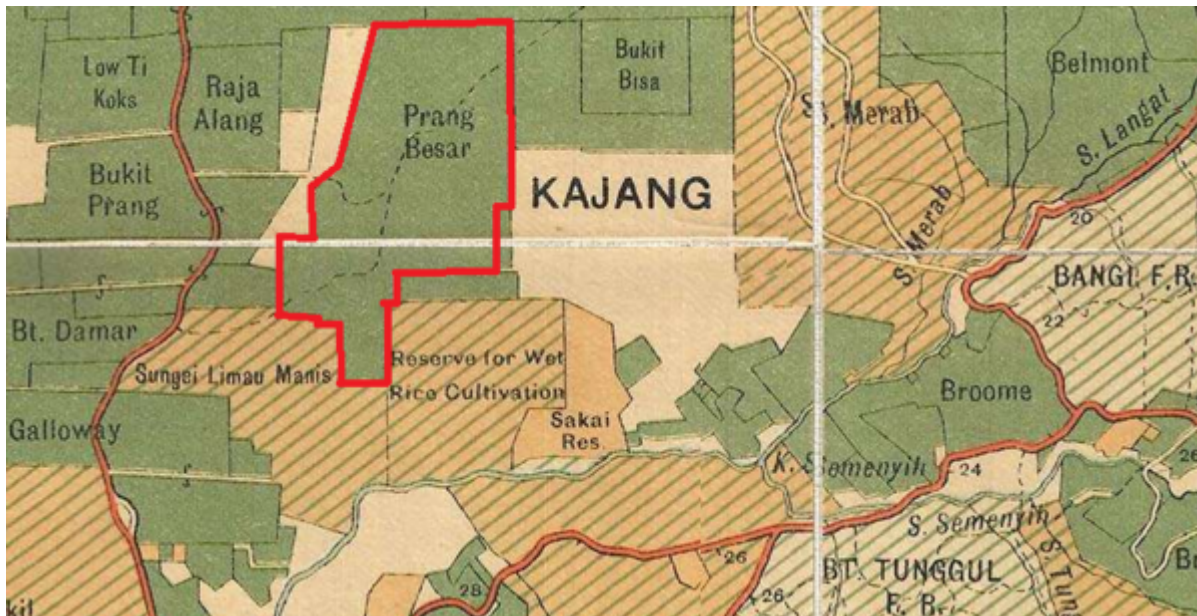

Ladang Prang Besar memohon sebidang tanah di dalam Hutan Simpan Bangi untuk tujuan penyelidikan tanaman getah.

CATATAN: Permohonan ini diluluskan, namun penyelidikan di situ tidak dapat bertahan lama akibat gangguan haiwan liar Hutan Simpan Bangi: "As far back as 1924, Gough established two seed gardens, each protected against pollinating agents from outside by some 25 chains of jungle. His diary recorded his objective: "To discover three types of improved breeding value". These gardens situated in the Bangi jungle had to be abandoned because of attack by monkeys and other predators. Later seed gardens were successfully established within coconut plantations located on the Bagan Datoh peninsula in Lower Perak. Seedlings from the Prang Besar Isolation Garden (PBIG) and Prang Besar Gough Garden (PBIG-GG) have been widely planted in Malaysia and overseas." (VD Nair, 1990-an:

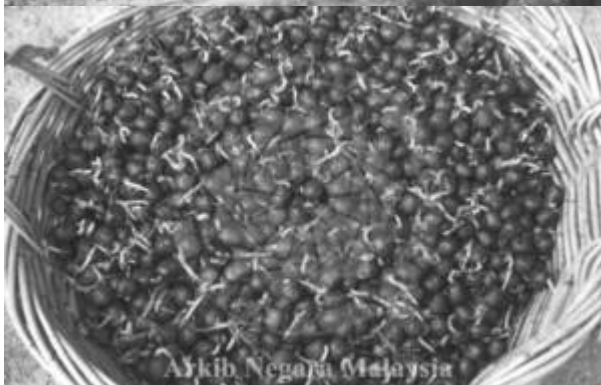

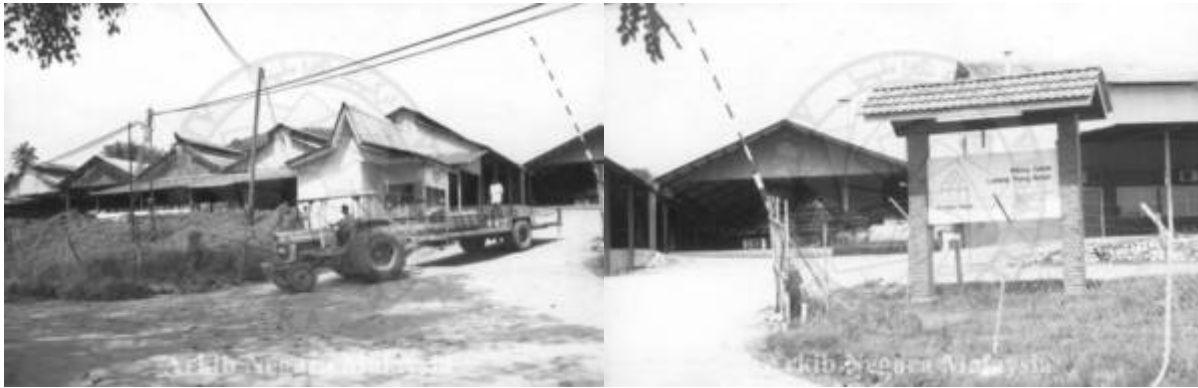
